# **Get Permission First**



#### **AT LOCAL EVENTS**

Many Media Missionaries have created EWTN INFORMATION tables! The Media Missionary office supplies the materials and they present the materials at a lo-

cal festival, conference, baseball game, or other local event. Host an EWTN Information table at a local religious event or conference and see how much fun it is!

#### **SCHOOLS**

Campus sharing can be challenging, but we have suggestions:

 A college or university will usually have a Catholic Student
 Association that you can bring EWTN materials to.




- A local catholic church, maybe not your own, may have a school where you can share materials too.
- Contacting a school administrator is a good way to start; ask if they might let you bring them materials for their students to see.
- Sometimes teachers share brochures with their class, so you may want to offer them resources too.

#### **HOSPITALS & REHABILITATION CENTERS**

Share about EWTN and suggest that they carry EWTN TV or Radio at their facility if they don't already have it. Leave brochures and flyers with:


#### **IN-PERSON**
